## Nursery and Reception - Forest School in "Our Secret Garden"

Forest School sessions got off to a great start this week. We began each session teaching the children our welcome song, followed by the rules and motto of Forest School. The children explored the area using a scavenger hunt to guide them. Lots of discussion could be heard amongst the children as they discussed where to find the different objects and comparisons were made between them. The children very quickly sorted the materials which enabled us to share what we have most of on the site and what is harder to find.

We introduced the Friendship tree (the central cherry tree) and used the natural objects to create friendly faces in small groups. It was great to see the children wandering around and sharing positive comments about the achievements of their peers. Reception children also got the chance to create bird feeders out of pine cones, lard and bird seed. We hope that these will encourage a greater variety of birds into the garden and we are looking forward to seeing what has happened to them next week. Nursery children and some of the Reception children also enjoyed finding mini beasts and identifying them under the creature peepers. Some were even brave enough to try holding a snail and a worm on their hand.

We were so impressed with how enthusiastic and inquisitive the children were in the sessions. See you next week Nursery and Reception!

### And Finally

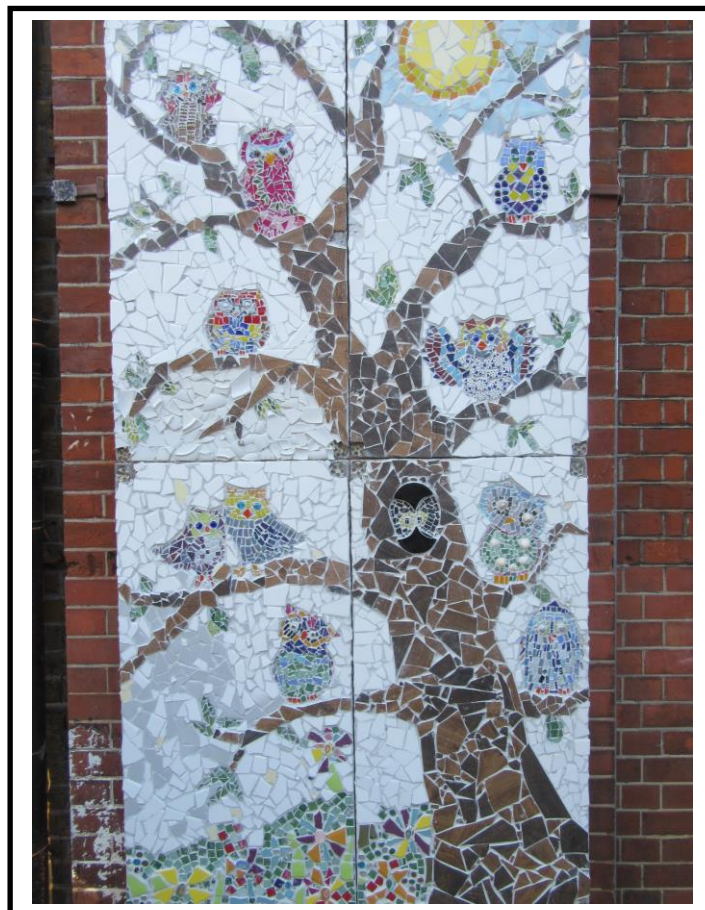
