Attendance across the school last week was 94.02%, with an unauthorised absence level of 1.33%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 94.90% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.66%. Let's keep working together to improve these figures even further! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.

Remember...when your child is not in school, they are always noted as being absent. Please ensure you contact the office to explain your child's absence. A reason of "sick" or "unwell" **IS NOT** sufficient and will not be recorded in the register as authorised.

The local authority has a statutory duty to check our school registers on a regular basis and impose fines where they deem appropriate. Any money raised by fining families go straight to Camden. Three families will be contacted by Camden Education Welfare for taking unauthorised holidays last half term. In addition, one family was fined by the local authority for taking unauthorised holidays at the end of the Autumn Term. Please be aware that this fine is £60 per child per parent if paid within two weeks and increases to £120 per child per parent if paid after this date. If unpaid, the local authority will take families to court.

There were 65 lates last week (9 more than the previous week) involving 49 children (15 more than the previous week) throughout the school. **Let's make sure we continue to improve this!**
