Attendance across the school last week was 92.83%, with an unauthorised absence level of 1.88%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 95.07% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.83%. Let's keep working together to improve these figures even further! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.

There were 95 lates last week (**A MASSIVE 71 more than the previous week**) involving 64 children (**A MASSIVE 43 more than the previous week**) throughout the school.

Punctuality is a vital life skill - and also plain good manners. The school day starts promptly and immediately after the register has been taken. If children do arrive late they find it very hard to catch up on the work they have missed AND they interrupt the other children who are getting on with their learning!

Camden Cup Football Results

Our boys and girls football teams recently played in the CSSA cup tournament. As one of the top schools in the league this year, we played in the 'Champions League' cup tournament for the Top 10 teams. In the group stage, both teams were in a group of five. The girls team, in the 6-A-Side tournament, played all their games with only five players, owing to absences on the day of the tournament. In the circumstances, they did splendidly, losing only one of their four games in the group, drawing with Gospel Oak 1-1 (the eventual winners), Fitzjohns 0-0 and Rosary 0-0, and losing to Beckford 2-0. Very well done to all the girls in the team: Louise (Y5); Lola-Rose, Amina, Maizi and Maria (Y6). In their group, the boys won three of their games, beating Carlton 2-0, Fitzjohns 1-0 and Richard Cobden 1-0. In their other game, they drew with Brookfield 0-0. The boys came first in their group and progressed to the semi-finals, where they lost narrowly to St. Aloysius, the eventual cup winners, 1-0. In the play-off for 3rd place, the boys lost on penalties after the game against Brookfield finished 0-0. It was a tough day for the boys, as we travelled to the tournament without any substitutes. CSSA Cricket Tournament Results

Our boys and girls cricket teams recently participated in the Camden cricket tournament, attempting to defend the trophies we won in 2017. Ten schools took part in the competition. The girls were in a group of five, and tied for top place with two other teams, after winning their games against Beckford, St. Albans and Fitzjohns and losing to Brookfield. Three teams had the same win/loss record after their four games, but when it went to head-to-head run difference, New End just missed out on going through to the semi-finals. Very bad luck. Well done to all the girls in the team: Lily, Elsa, Amina, Lola-Rose, Khadija, Maria, Emma, Macey and Leila (all Y6). In their group, the boys won all their four games, beating Beckford, Brookfield, Fitzjohns and St. Albans. They topped their group and progressed to the semi-final stage, where they beat Gospel Oak comfortably. In the final, the boys came up against a very strong Emmanuel team who proved too good for us on the day. Bad luck boys!
