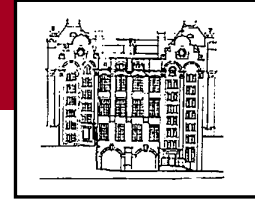

Attendance across the school last week was 96.70%, with an unauthorised absence level of 1.65%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 95.14% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.80%. Let's keep working together to improve these figures even further! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.



There were 20 lates last week (33 less than the previous week) involving 17 children (23 less than the previous week) throughout the school. **Let's try to keep up these record lows!**

Punctuality is a vital life skill - and also plain good manners. The school day starts promptly and immediately after the register has been taken the children are straight into their first lesson, usually English or mathematics. If children do arrive late they find it very hard to catch up on the work they have missed. If children arrive after the register has been taken they will be marked as L (late). Any child who arrives at school from 9.20am onwards will be marked as U (unauthorised late). This will count as an unauthorised absence.

Camden Year 3&4 Football League Tournament Finals

At the end of last half-term, our boys and girls Year 3&4 football teams competed in the finals of the Camden league tournament. Of the 22 school teams starting out in the competition, the best eight teams played in the finals, progressing from the preliminary rounds. The girls had a tough afternoon, losing the three games in their finals group, 1-0 to Edith Neville, 4-0 to Gospel Oak and 1-0 to Rhyl, though two of the three games, as the scores suggest, were very close. The final position in the league for the girls was 7th out of 22. Very creditable and the girls should be very proud of their performances in all the seven games they played in the competition.
