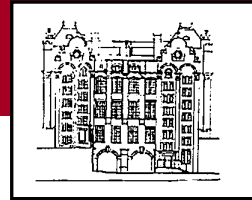

Attendance across the school last week was 94.82%, with an unauthorised absence level of 1.53%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 94.89% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.82%. Let's keep working together to improve these figures even further! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.



There were 25 lates last week (13 more than the previous week) involving 20 children (9 more than the previous week) throughout the school. **Let's make sure we keep these figures low!**

Secondary Transfer Meetings

Two meetings will be held to discuss secondary transfer - one at **9.15** and repeated at **6.30pm** on **Wednesday, 27th June**.

Parents of Year 5 and Year 4 children are **strongly advised** to attend one of these meetings but they may also be of use to other parents as well.

These meetings will look at all aspects of the application process including visits and on-line forms as well as how offers are made. We will also look at what happens if you do not get a place in the school of your choice.

Please be aware that parents with children in Year 6 from September will need to make their secondary choices BEFORE 31st October 2018.

GDPR

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a new, Europe-wide law that replaces the Data Protection Act 1998 in the UK. It is part of the wider package of reform to the data protection landscape that includes the Data Protection Bill. The GDPR sets out requirements for how organisations will need to handle personal data from 25 May 2018.

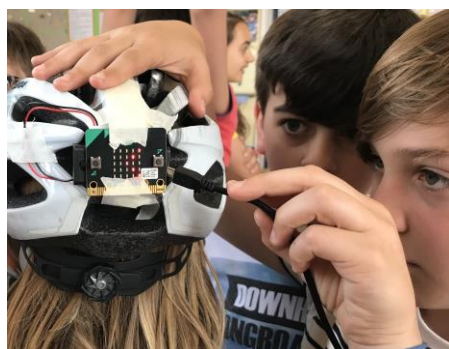

Computing News - Coding and Robotics

Over the last couple of weeks we have started to look at basic robotics in coding lessons. Older pupils have both been programming tiny 'Microbit' micro-controllers. These are the tiny computers that are used to control all sorts of things from step-counters, stopwatches, thermometers and even drones. Pupils have learnt how technology like this can be used to prototype new inventions and ideas.



Year 5 and Year 6 created simple bike lights, learning how to make them flash. Pupils found how to use tilt sensors to make a direction indicator. Some Year 5 pupils went even further and attached their microbit to Percy's bike helmet!

Year 2,3 and 4 have been working with our new 'Edison' robots. They have learnt how create a special program on a laptop, download it to the robot to make it move, and follow a sequences of commands.
