Attendance across the school last week was 96.85%, with an unauthorised absence level of 0.76%. Remember that good attendance is seen as 96% or better. Attendance to date this academic year is 94.95% with an unauthorised absence level of 0.82%. Let's keep working together to improve these figures even further! Parents and carers are reminded that any absence from school is considered an absence on your child's record.
